University of Toronto Professor Honoured in Skopje



Canadian Macedonian Place congratulates University of Toronto professor, Christina Kramer on receiving an honorary doctorate in Philology from Saints Cyril and Methodius University in Skopje. In October 2017, Professor Kramer was honoured for her contributions to the development of the Macedonian language, literature and culture. Professor Kramer has been teaching the Macedonian language course at the University of Toronto for over 30 years. This year her beginner class is comprised of both a multi-level and multi-generational group. There are 18 undergraduates, of which at least three are non-Macedonian, and the students have a wide-range of language skills from total beginners

to those proficient in their home dialect but seeking to learn Macedonian in order to differentiate dialect from the standard language. In addition, there are more than a dozen auditors of varied ages.

The following is from Prof. Kramer's acceptance speech in Skopje:

"I could not have accomplished what I have done at the University of Toronto without the early, and consistent support of the Macedonian Community in Toronto who, through their donations every year, let me develop a regular Macedonian course. Hundreds of students have taken the course in the past thirty years, and several thousand more have benefitted through the publication of the Macedonian grammar. To have the support of a community like this and Canadian Macedonian Place is a rarity."



"I met Jim in 1977 and I was amazed at his energy and dedication to the project that would later become Canadian Macedonian Place. At each board meeting he would report on meetings with the village societies and the Matitsa in Macedonia. In those early days before CMP was built, we had meetings at the homes of directors and Jim and his wife Dorothy hosted several meetings at their home. Those were certainly exciting times. Jim was so affable and such a friendly person, well-liked by everyone, making him an excellent person when it came to soliciting donations for CMP."

Sadly, 2017, was also the year that we lost several community leaders including: Alex Alexander, a past President of CMP, an important member of the Golf Committee and a supporter until his final days. Hope Paliare, a well-respected and loved community member and the mother of Chris Paliare, one of CMPF's longest serving Board Members and one of the most respected lawyers in his field. In addition, there were several other community members who passed away last year and although this space does not allow for us to list them all, we recognize all those that offer a lasting legacy to our community by donations in memory to Canadian Macedonian Place.

On behalf of our entire Board of Directors, I would like to thank everyone past, present and future that contributes to, or requests that donations be made to CMP in memory of a family member or friend. Obituaries for our loved Macedonian community

Alex Alexander an Evening of Remembrance



On October 23rd, 2017, Olga Alexander presented a memorial of her husband Alex for a group of family and friends at the Prince Hotel in Toronto.

John Evans acted as Master of Ceremony and he referred to Mr. and Mrs. Alexander's life together as a 56-year honeymoon. John offered the attendees a glimpse into the life of Alex Alexander and his contributions to Canadian Macedonian Place.


On May 7, 1978, the official ground breaking ceremonies took place on the site of Canadian Macedonian Place, a not-for-profit seniors apartment complex providing excellent, affordable and subsidized accommodation and services to Macedonians and friends of the Macedonian community.

Alex Alexander was instrumental in this effort and an avid supporter of Canadian Macedonian Place. To help raise funds for CMP, he started a second golf tournament called the Canadian Macedonian

Open at his own golf course. Alex's tournament ran successfully from 1978 to 1988 and donated \$1,000 in proceeds each year to Canadian Macedonian Place, until which time he sold his golf course. Alex Alexander was President of CMP for one year 1984/85 and a member of the Board of Directors from 1981 to 1991. Additionally, Alex served on the golf committee for over two decades.

Alex was also an instrumental participant in Oro Makedonsko, a fundraising effort led by John Bitove Sr. that took place at Roy Thomson Hall. Throughout his life, Alex always offered his help and his financial support for Canadian Macedonian Place and all things related to the advancement of Macedonian culture and causes.

Alex Alexander remained a respected member of the Canadian Macedonian community and a valued Board member of CMP. He will be missed, by all who knew and loved him.



Hope Paliare, 1920 to 2017

In her 98th year, Hope Paliare passed away peacefully on October 10, 2017. Born in Toronto to Macedonian parents (Oshima) in 1920, she managed to outlive her husband, all of her siblings, friends, and sadly, her beloved daughter Faith Croxon (Noel).

Hope and her husband Norm lovingly fed generations of Danforth Tech students and teachers at their restaurant, the Normandy. She spent her life from a very early age caring for others, whether family, friends or strangers. Hope had no shortage of love for all who came within her sphere. Even in her later years when life became more difficult, she maintained her perpetually positive disposition and warm smile.

She will be missed by her son Chris, her daughter-in-law, Eva Marszewski and her two precious granddaughters, whom she loved dearly, Zoe (Adam Delva) and Julia as well as by many nieces and nephews.

Hope's son Chris Paliare has been a vital member of the CMP Board of Directors, lending his legal advice and expertise in support of the CMP foundation for over two decades.

Evangelia Elieff 1919 to 2017

Evangelia Elieff was born on March 15, 1919, in the city of Lerin, Macedonia.

Raised in a family of five siblings during the 1920's, 30's and 40's, Evangelia and her family survived the Italian invasion, the German occupation, the Allied Forces intrusion, and the many years of Greek aggression and human rights deprivation forced upon the Macedonian people.

Acting against social and political injustices Evangelia marched, carrying placards in protest of Greek policies. She smuggled food to imprisoned friends, relatives and to the Partizans who battled from the countryside and hills.

In 1947, Evangelia left the friends and family she loved and came to Canada for the prospect of a new life and marriage. She travelled with just her clothes, her memories, a passport, and an address to her sister's house on Mulock Avenue in Toronto. She married Chris Elieff in 1947. They moved to Windsor, had two sons (Lou and Harry), opened a bakery, and worked together. In 1956, they bought a home in East York and opened another bakery. Chris died on March 2, 1970.

Evangelia passed away on November 8, 2017. A much loved and cherished mother, baba, family member and friend, she was an inspiration to the people who knew her and a courageous fighter and survivor right to the end.
